Purpose:

The Ashton Rhodes Memorial Scholarship is a program established to assist young men and women in securing financial aid for formal education beyond high school.

Who is eligible for the Scholarship?

Any graduating senior that is associated with, or whose parent(s) or legal guardian(s) are associated with, local Emergency Services (Fire, EMS, Law Enforcement, etc.). The graduating senior must be enrolled in one of the five (5) Lenoir County High Schools (South Lenoir, North Lenoir, Kinston High, Bethel Academy, or Parrott Academy)

How are recipients of the Scholarship determined?

Recipients are selected annually by the Sandy Bottom Fire & Rescue Scholarship Committee based on financial need, character, scholarship, community involvement, academic promise and desire by the applicant for further education or training.

What is the amount of the Scholarship?

The Scholarship is a one-time award of \$750, issued to the student. The number of Scholarships awarded each year may vary, usually not to exceed 4, based on recommendations of the Scholarship Committee.

What is the deadline for applying?

Applications must be received by the President or Secretary of the Fire Department no later than 5:00pm on May 4, 2015. Applications may be hand-delivered to the Fire Station or mailed to the following address:

1. Reference letters from the High School or College Educator, typed or using enclosed form.
2. High School transcript.
3. A written essay between 100 and 500 words on the applicant's educational plans, including personal and career goals, and why the applicant is choosing said career path.
